<mark>Mark 4:23</mark>

23 If any man have ears to hear let him hear.

Let me ask you today, Are you spiritually minded? Do you have Christ in you? Are you born again?

There is a price one must pay, to hear the words of Jesus.

In the Bible, Jesus spoke to those that denied him, that rejected him and said; If you had not seen, then you had not sinned. That is if you had not heard Jesus preach the Gospel of –Repent for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand, then you would not be held responsible, liable, accountable for your sins. But Jesus went on to say to them, but you say WE DO SEE, WE DO HEAR, WE DO UNDERSTAND, we are not blind; therefore they judged themselves saying we are accountable. Therefore Jesus said, since you say you see; then your sins remain, because they did not repent and were not baptized of John to accept Christ when he came to have their sins forgiven.

<mark>Mark 4:24-25</mark>

24 And he said unto them, Take heed what ye hear: with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you: and unto you that hear shall more be given.

25 For he that hath, to him shall be given: and he that hath not, from him shall be taken even that which he hath.

Take Heed What You Hear!!!! Unto you that *Hear*-more shall be given! He that heareth not from him shall be taken even that which he has.

Mete: to distribute, to deal out-to share. With what measure you are willing to accept the Word of God and to share it with others, is the same measure Jesus will continue to give unto you.

Matthew 25:14-30

14 The Parable of the Talents For the kingdom of heaven is as a man travelling into a far country, who called his own servants, and delivered unto them his goods.

15 And unto one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one; to every man according to his several ability; and straightway took his journey.

16 Then he that had received the five talents went and traded with the same, and made them other five talents.

17 And likewise he that had received two, he also gained other two.18 But he that had received one went and digged in the earth, and hid his lord's money.

19 After a long time the lord of those servants cometh, and reckoneth with them.

20 And so he that had received five talents came and brought other five talents, saying, Lord, thou deliveredst unto me five talents: behold, I have gained beside them five talents more.

21 His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.

22 He also that had received two talents came and said, Lord, thou deliveredst unto me two talents: behold, I have gained two other talents beside them.

23 His lord said unto him, Well done, good and faithful servant; thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.

24 Then he which had received the one talent came and said, Lord, I knew thee that thou art an hard man, reaping where thou hast not sown, and gathering where thou hast not strowed:

25 And I was afraid, and went and hid thy talent in the earth: lo, there thou hast that is thine.

26 His lord answered and said unto him, Thou wicked and slothful servant, thou knewest that I reap where I sowed not, and gather where I have not strowed:

27 Thou oughtest therefore to have put my money to the exchangers, and then at my coming I should have received mine own with usury. 28 Take therefore the talent from him, and give it unto him which hath ten talents.

29 For unto every one that hath shall be given, and he shall have abundance: but from him that hath not shall be taken away even that which he hath.

30 And cast ye the unprofitable servant into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

To those servants who took what the Master gave them and shared it, they received gain and the Lord said unto them well done my good and faithful servant.

But to that servant that did not share his talent but hid it, the Lord pronounced judgment upon him. Thou wicked and slothful servant.

Apostle Paul spoke to Timothy through the anointing of the Holy Ghost.

1 Timothy 4:12-13

12 Let no man despise thy youth; but be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity. 13 Till I come, give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine.

1 Timothy 4:15-16

15 Meditate upon these things; give thyself wholly to them; that thy profiting may appear to all.

16 Take heed unto thyself, and unto the doctrine; continue in them: for in doing this thou shalt both save thyself, and them that hear thee.

2 Timothy 2:15

15 Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

Do you desire to hear the voice of Jesus Christ?---Leading you?, Directing your way, guiding you? Toward everlasting life? Then hear what Jesus said unto the churches in Revelation.

Then hear what Jesus is saying unto us! The book of Revelation-Jesus is speaking to the Church;

Jesus is saying to us today; "A promise-to him that overcometh (sin) That is to those that repent, are baptized in Jesus name for remission of sins, and receive the gift of the Holy Ghost and continue on hearing the Word of God and doing the Lord's will—verse 7...to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the Paradise of God!
