

## In God's Likeness

### Genesis 1:26-27

26 And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

27 So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

God created man in his own image! In God's image! Male and female, created God them. After his likeness.

### Genesis 2:7

7 And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.

God's miracle of creating man after his own image after his own likeness! God created man like himself—Immortal---Eternal---everlasting Life. God created man to worship him-( God). God visited Adam and Eve in the cool of the evening for fellowship.

Man became God's son; Adam and Eve were God's son and daughter, his children. They were in one accord with each other. Man was sinless, God is always and forever sinless. Man was completely in the fellowship with God! For man in the beginning was created sinless.

### John 3:16

8 And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

**Revelation 21:6**
