Psalms 118:24

24 This is the day which the LORD hath made; we will rejoice and be glad in it.

Psalms 37:3-5

- 3 <u>Trust in the LORD</u>, and <u>do good</u>; so shalt thou dwell in the land, and verily thou shalt be fed.
- 4 <u>Delight thyself also in the LORD</u>; and **he shall give thee the desires of thine heart.**
- 5 Commit thy way unto the LORD; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass.

Proverbs 3:3-7

- 3 <u>Let not mercy and truth forsake thee</u>: **bind them** about thy neck; **write them** upon the table of thine heart:
- 4 So shalt thou find favour and good understanding in the sight of God and man.
- 5 <u>Trust in the LORD with all thine heart;</u> and <u>lean not unto thine own understanding.</u>
- 6 In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.
- 7 Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil.

Psalms 34:8

8 O taste and see that the LORD is good: blessed is the man that trusteth in him.

Psalms 145:18-20

- 18 The <u>LORD</u> is nigh unto all them that call upon him, to all that call upon him <u>in truth</u>.
- 19 He will fulfil the desire of them **that fear him:** he also will hear their cry, and will save them.
- 20 The LORD preserveth all them that love him: but all the wicked will he destroy.

Luke 12:29-32

- 29 And <u>seek not</u> ye what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink, **neither be ye of doubtful mind.**
- 30 For all these things do the nations of the world seek after: and <u>your Father knoweth that ye have need of these things.</u>
- 31 But **rather seek ye the kingdom of God**; and all these things shall be added unto you.
- 32 <u>Fear not</u>, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.

Proverbs 16:3

3 Commit thy works unto the LORD, and thy thoughts shall be established.

Isaiah 55:6-9

- 6 Seek ye the LORD while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near:
- 7 Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the LORD, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon.
- 8 For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the LORD.
- 9 For <u>as the heavens are higher than the</u> earth, <u>so are my ways higher than your ways</u>, and <u>my thoughts than your thoughts</u>.

Isaiah 40:28-29

- 28 Hast thou not known? hast thou not heard, that the everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth, fainteth not, neither is weary? there is no searching of his understanding.
- 29 He giveth power to the faint; and to them that have no might he increaseth strength.

Matthew 5:6

6 Blessed are they which do **hunger and thirst after righteousness:** for <u>they shall</u> be filled.

John 8:31-32

- 31 Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, **If ye continue in my word**, then are ye my disciples indeed;
- 32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

James 1:2-4

2 My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations;

- 3 Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience.
- 4 But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing.

Romans 5:3-6

- 3 And not only so, but **we glory in tribulations also:** knowing that tribulation worketh patience;
- 4 And patience, experience; and experience, hope:
- 5 And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.
- 6 For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.

Romans 8:28-39

- 28 And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.
- 29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate **to be conformed to the image of his Son**, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.
- 30 Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.
- 31 What shall we then say to these things? **If God be for us, who can be against us?**
- 32 He that <u>spared not his own Son</u>, but **delivered him up for us all**, how shall he not with him also <u>freely give us all things?</u>
- 33 Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth.
- 34 Who is he that condemneth? It is **Christ** that died, **yea rather**, **that is risen again**, who is even at the right hand of God, who also **maketh intercession for us**.
- 35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?
- 36 As it is written, <u>For thy sake we are killed all the day long</u>; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter.
- 37 Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.
- 38 For **I am persuaded**, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come,
- 39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, <u>shall be able to separate us from the love of God</u>, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Psalms 126:5-6

5 They that sow in tears shall reap in joy.

6 He that goeth forth and weepeth, bearing precious seed, <u>shall doubtless come</u> <u>again with rejoicing</u>, <u>bringing his sheaves with him</u>.

Job 1:21

21 And said, <u>Naked came I out of my mother's womb</u>, and <u>naked shall I return</u> thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; <u>blessed be the name</u> of the LORD.

James 5:7-11

- 7 **Be patient** therefore, brethren, unto the coming of the Lord. Behold, the husbandman waiteth for the precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience for it, until he receive the early and **latter rain.**
- 8 **Be ye also patient; stablish your hearts:** for the coming of the Lord draweth nigh.
- 9 Grudge not one against another, brethren, <u>lest ye be condemned:</u> behold, <u>the judge standeth before the door.</u>
- 10 Take, my brethren, the prophets, who have spoken in the name of the Lord, for an example of suffering affliction, and of patience.
- 11 Behold, we count them happy which endure. <u>Ye have heard of the patience of Job</u>, and have seen the end of the Lord; <u>that the Lord is very pitiful</u>, and of tender <u>mercy</u>.

Psalms 34:15-19

- 15 The eyes of the LORD are upon the righteous, and his ears are open unto their cry.
- 16 The face of the LORD is against them that do evil, to cut off the remembrance of them from the earth.
- 17 The righteous cry, and the LORD heareth, and delivereth them out of all their troubles.
- 18 The LORD is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit.
- 19 **Many are the afflictions of the righteous:** <u>but the LORD delivereth him out of them all.</u>

Matthew 11:28-30

- 28 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- 29 **Take my yoke upon you,** and **learn of me;** for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.
- 30 For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.

Psalms 55:22

22 <u>Cast thy burden upon the LORD</u>, and <u>he shall sustain thee</u>: **he shall never suffer the righteous to be moved**.

Hebrews 13:5

5 Let your conversation be <u>without covetousness</u>; and **be content with such things** as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.

Psalms 9:9-11

- 9 The <u>LORD</u> also will be a refuge for the oppressed, a refuge in times of trouble. 10 And they that **know thy name** will put their trust in thee: for **thou, LORD**, **hast not forsaken them that seek thee.**
- 11 Sing praises to the LORD, which dwelleth in Zion: declare among the people his doings.

- 23 The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD: and he delighteth in his way.
- 24 Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down: for the LORD upholdeth him with his hand.
- 25 <u>I have been young, and now am old</u>; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread.

1 Peter 5:6-10

- 6 <u>Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God</u>, that **he may exalt you in due time:**
- 7 <u>Casting all your care upon him;</u> for he careth for you.
- 8 Be **sober**, be **vigilant**; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom **he may** devour:
- 9 Whom **resist stedfast in the faith,** knowing that the <u>same afflictions are accomplished</u> in your brethren that are in the world.
- 10 But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle you.

Psalms 27:14

14 Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD.

Isaiah 40:29-31

- 29 He giveth power to the faint; and to them that have no might he increaseth strength.
- 30 Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall:
- 31 But **they that wait upon the LORD** shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and <u>not be weary;</u> and they shall walk, and not faint.

Isaiah 30:18

18 And therefore will the LORD wait, that he may be gracious unto you, and therefore will he be exalted, that he may have mercy upon you: for the LORD is a God of judgment: blessed are all they that wait for him.
