We *should* not, we *will* not, I *will* not be *satisfied* in our walk with Jesus Christ **UNTIL** we see the **full glory** and **power** of God manifested by the Holy Ghost in us; the Church, the Body of Christ.

Church! The Lord Jesus Christ has *given* us 9 Gifts of Power.

I Corinthians 12: 4-11 reads,

4 Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit.

5 And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord.

6 And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all.

7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.

8 For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit;

9 To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit;

10 To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues:

11 But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will.

Saints, we should *never* be *satisfied* or content in our Spiritual walk with God, **UNTIL** we see all **9 Gifts** of the **Holy Ghost** in **operation** in the body of Christ, in us, the Church of the Living God.

Ephesians 4: 11-13 reads,

11 And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers;

12 For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ:

13 Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:

We should *never* be *satisfied* **UNTIL** we see the **5-fold Ministry** of **Apostles, Prophets, Evangelists, Pastors, and Teachers** operating in the Church.

We should *never* be *satisfied* UNTIL we see the *manifestation* of the 9 Fruits of the Spirit of God.

Galations 5:22-23 reads,

22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,

23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

We should never be satisfied in the Holy Ghost UNTIL we see the Fruits of the Spirit working in us.

We should *never* be *satisfied* UNTIL we see the dead raised, the blinded eyes opened, the maimed to be made whole, the lame to walk, the deaf to hear, the dumb to speak, and to see the lost, saved.

This is our inheritance from Christ, this is our promise from Jesus.

Mark 16: 17-18 reads,

17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

James 5:13-15 reads,

13 Is any among you afflicted? let him pray. Is any merry? let him sing psalms.

14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

15 And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

Church do not *settle* for a form of Godliness, but *deny* the Power thereof.

We are the Sons of God, we are the children of Jesus Christ. We should *never* be *satisfied* in our walk with God UNTIL, we see our unsaved loved ones born again of the water and of the spirit;

UNTIL, we see our friends and neighbors saved, UNTIL Revival fills the Church. We should *never* be *satisfied* UNTIL, we see the Power of God, the Glory of God.

Paul said, I do not come unto you with enticing words of man's wisdom;

but in the demonstration of the Power of the Holy Ghost (the power *is* the power of the Holy Ghost). Paul said when I do come to you, I want to see the Power that you claim to have in Jesus.

Church the world is looking for the *true Power of God!*
Show me the Power!
Show me God's glory!

Apostle Philip spoke to Jesus and said, show us God the Father and we will be satisfied! Jesus said, to Philip when you have seen me you have seen the Father.

I say when we see Jesus we shall see the Power and Glory of God!

We will *not* be *satisfied* UNTIL we wake up in Jesus' image!

We shall *never* be *satisfied* UNTIL we wake up in heaven!

We are complete in Jesus who is the head of all Principality and Power, and we shall receive Power after the Holy Ghost has come upon us.

Church we will *never* be *satisfied* UNTIL we hear Jesus say," Well done my good and faithful servant enter you in to the rest of the Lord".
